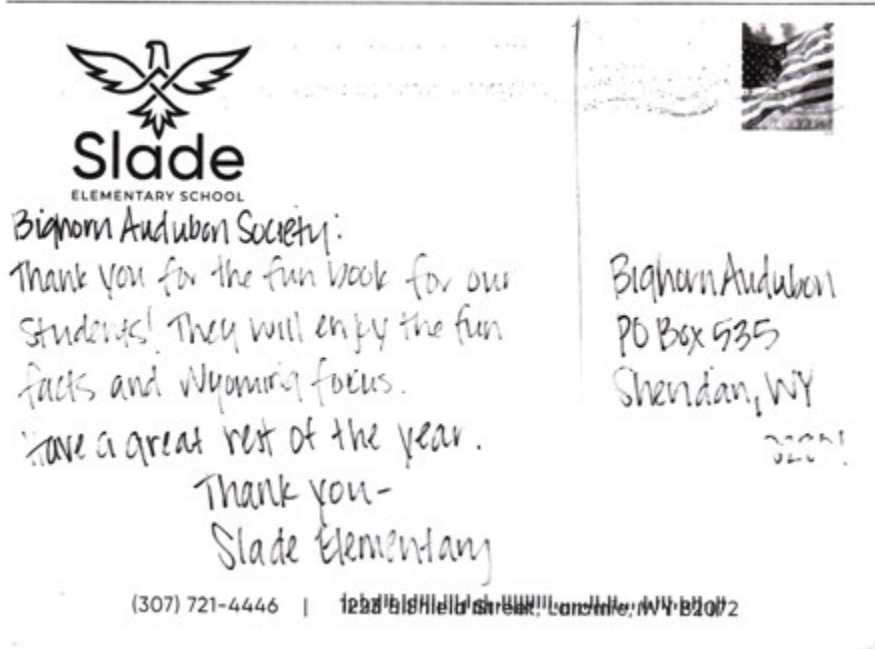

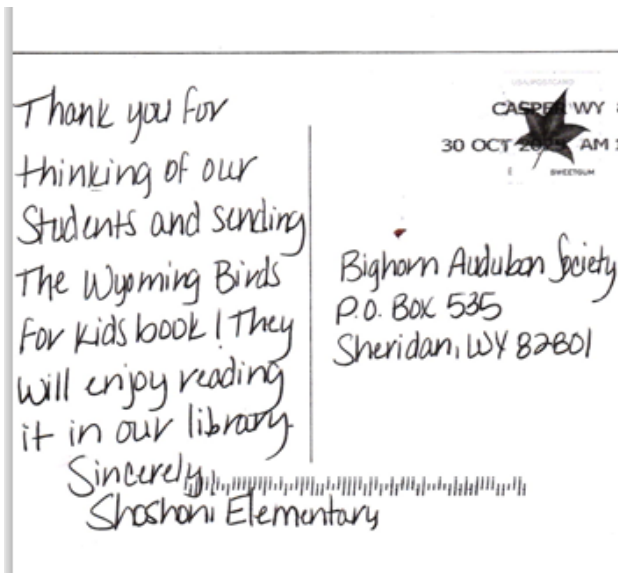


Dear Friends of PCSD#1,

Loves the book, but the kids there are hunters and fishers, so it has not been checked out. Maybe in the fall, we could have an author reading to get kids excited about birds?

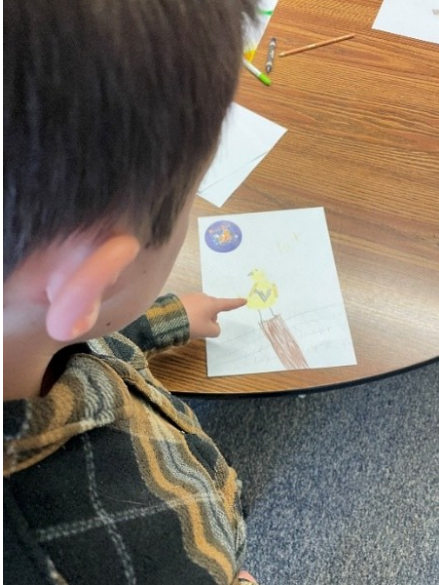
They have added the book to the reference section and do not allow it to be checked out.

They got all the books and are keeping 2 of them for replacement copies. (phone)

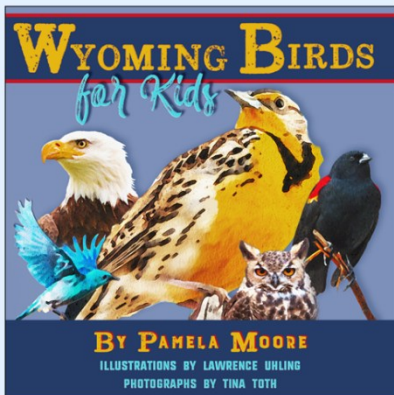
